What is Experiential Learning?

- A process through which students develop knowledge, skills, and values from direct experiences outside of a traditional academic setting
- Exploration through experience!
- Types of Experiential Learning
 - » Ex: Internships, undergraduate research, study abroad, service learning, fellowships, research assistantships, student teaching, and volunteering




Internship Facts

- Paid internships at CU Denver average \$14-\$16/hr



EUReCA!

- EUReCA! Work Study
 - » Uses Federal Work-Study awards to support students in research
 - » Matches students with qualified faculty
- EUReCA! Fellows Program
 - » Highly competitive summer research program
 - 40 hours a week
 - » \$4,500 stipend
 - » Open to all disciplines
 - Meant for experienced student researchers
- Summer Lynx Academy
 - » Entering research for new students
 - » Course code: UNIV 1111



Research Facts

- Research: Scholarly activity in your field of study
 - » Not just working in a lab
- There are funding opportunities!
 - » Check your work-study eligibility
- Research experience matters
 - » Extensive research experience makes you a stronger candidate for graduate school and many fields






Summary
